SPRING NATIONAL OUTREACH | RULES AND INFORMATION

1. **ENTRIES:** Entries for the October Classic close Monday, March 25, 2019.
Exhibitors may pay either by check or credit card. Entries may be submitted online by credit card, at www.horseshowtime.com or equestrianconnect.com, or by mailing in the entry form with your method of payment to:

 - a. Exhibitors may elect to pre-pay all fees before the closing date of entries or may elect to pay the total of:
 - 1.) A deposit fee of \$50 per horse
 - 2.) All stall and tack room fees
 - b. If entry blanks are postmarked on or before the entry closing date and are properly filled out, the \$50 deposit will be credited to the entries due.
Late and/or improper entries will forfeit the entry deposit fee.
TO BE COMPLETE, ENTRY FORMS MUST INCLUDE:
 - 1.) Horse's name and complete descriptions
 - 2.) All classes or sections entered
 - 3.) All mandatory signatures
 - c. Trainers and owners may leave a signed, open check or credit card authorization for charges during show.
Please close all accounts by 5:00 p.m. Saturday.
 - d. **There will be no late fee assessed.**
2. **CREDIT CARDS:** Exhibitors wishing to pay by credit card will be charged a 3% convenience fee per entry.
Charges to credit cards come through on statements from the Washington State Hunter Jumper Association (WSHJA).
3. **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS:** Entries must be paid by draft payable in US Funds or check on Canadian US Dollar account.
(We are not able to accept Canadian checks with US Funds written on the check face.)
4. **ADDS & SCRATCHES:** Please fill out an add/scratch form in the show office to add or scratch a class.
5. **NOMINATION FEE:** Horses or ponies entered in any hunter, jumper, or equitation classes at this show must pay a \$20 Nomination Fee. This fee allows entries to add / scratch classes in the show office..
6. **SUBSTITUTIONS:** A new horse/pony may be substituted for a scratched horse/pony for a \$25 office charge.
7. **CANCELLATIONS & REFUNDS:** Exhibitors cancelling entries after the closing date shall forfeit their entry fees, except in the case of disability of a horse, when entries shall be refunded, upon presentation to the Show Secretary, a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian prior to the first class in which the horse is entered.
 - a. There will be a \$25 office charge for all refunds.
 - b. No refund of stall fees unless requested directly to the show secretary before March 28, 2019.
 - c. Refunds will be mailed within three weeks after the Horse Show.
8. **HORSE SHOW CROSS ENTRY:** Cross entry is allowed between the Spring National Inaugural and the Spring National Inaugural Outreach shows. However, you may not enter the same division in both shows, i.e. the same horse and rider combination cannot compete in the Hunters 2'6" division in both shows. Exhibitors who show in at least one class of both shows must pay all applicable USEF, USHJA, and other horse show fees for the Spring National Inaugural horse show.
9. **RETURNED CHECKS OR CREDIT CARDS:** There will be a penalty of \$50 per check/credit card returned by the bank for any reason. To retain entries, the fees and penalty must be paid before the Horse Show starts. In the event a check/credit card is returned after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913.
10. **MANAGEMENT:** Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill to their satisfaction. Notice will be given to exhibitors affected. Management may start the first class of any session 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant. Management may change class orders to facilitate time schedule and conditions.
11. **RIBBONS:** Ribbons will be awarded to six places in all Hunter, Equitation and Jumper classes.
12. **HORSE SHOW OFFICE:** Show office hours are:
7:00 a.m. to 1/2 hour after end of show.

13. **STABLING:** Permanent box stalls with doors provided. First bedding and shavings for the show will be provided. Full week stalls will be available at 2:00 p.m. on Monday, April 1, 2019 and must be vacated no later than 9:00 a.m. Monday, April 9, 2019 . Fee for box stalls for the entire week shall be \$190. Weekend stalls (Friday - Sunday) shall be \$140. Please indicate arrival and departure date and who you are to be stabled with on the entry blank. Exhibitors do their own stall cleaning. Preference on requests for stalls will be given to exhibitors from out of the country, out of state, longest distance away, and promptness of entry. **No refund of stall fees unless requested directly to the Show Secretary before March 28 , 2019.** Refunds after those dates will only be made if the stall is reissued to another entry.
14. **SHAVINGS & MANURE DISPOSAL FEE:** There will be an \$85 per horse shavings & manure disposal fee. The fee for a weekend stall will be \$55.
15. **SCHOOLING & EXERCISE:** Schooling areas will be available for use before, during and after the show. Schooling in the San Juan ring will be allowed
on Friday, April 6, 2019 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A mandatory schooling fee of \$35 will be charged to all entries. Hard hats must be worn while schooling.

SPRING NATIONAL OUTREACH ONLY | RULES AND INFORMATION

16. MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from the operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and / or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and / or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

17. HELMETS: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials), SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials), SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.

18. TRAILER OR CAMPER HOOK-UPS: Trailer and camper hook-ups are available at a cost of \$200/week or \$50/day per space. Hook-up rates for the septic tank area will be \$250/week on a first come basis. A card will be issued at the horse show office and must be displayed in a window facing the parking area. Hook-ups will be patrolled and enforced. There will be a charge of \$125/week or \$30/day for trailers and campers that park overnight but do not use hook-ups.

19. HAUL-INS: There will be a charge of \$40 a day per horse for horses not stabled.

20. ARENAS & FOOTING: San Juan Ring is 200' x 130'. The schooling arena is 100' x 200'. The footing is sand on a sand base.

21. USHJA MEDAL CLASSES: All entrants to the USHJA Medal classes must be USHJA members at the Outreach level or higher.

22. OPTIONAL USHJA OUTREACH AWARDS: USHJA Membership at the \$35 Outreach level or higher is required for all riders wishing to earn points toward the USHJA year-end awards in the USHJA Outreach classes. If you want points, you must join USHJA in the show office before the end of the show. If you are already a USHJA member at the Outreach level or higher, be sure the show office has your USHJA number to receive points.
